Meaning: Inofficiously means in a manner that is unsolicited or not formally authorized, often involving offering opinions or information that was not requested.

1. She inofficiously offered her opinions on the matter, despite not being asked.
2. The committee had to address the inofficiously spread rumors that were causing confusion.
3. Although he meant well, his inofficiously given advice often led to more problems than solutions.
4. She inofficiously volunteered to organize the event, hoping to help her friends.
5. His inofficiously made comments during the meeting did not contribute to the discussion.
