

INQUISITORIALLY

Meaning: In an inquisitorial manner; characterized by a probing or questioning approach aimed at uncovering the truth.

1. The detective approached the suspect inquisitorially, probing for inconsistencies in his story.
2. Her inquisitorially raised eyebrows made it clear that she found his explanation insufficient.
3. During the debate, he questioned his opponent inquisitorially, seeking to uncover any hidden flaws in the argument.
4. The teacher looked at the student inquisitorially, sensing that something was not quite right.
5. As the panel interviewed the candidate, they did so inquisitorially, wanting to ensure thorough vetting for the position.
