Meaning: To inspissate means to thicken a liquid or substance by evaporation or concentration.

3. To create a thicker consistency, the artist chose to inspissate the paint before applying it to the canvas.

5. When the mixture began to inspissate, the researcher noted a change in its chemical properties.
