Meaning: Untenable: (adjective) incapable of being defended or maintained, especially in the face of new evidence or opposition.

1. The team's argument became untenable as new evidence emerged.
2. Her position on the matter was deemed untenable by her colleagues during the debate.
3. The company's financial situation was increasingly untenable, leading to urgent restructuring discussions.
4. After reviewing the data, the scientist realized that his hypothesis was untenable and needed revision.
5. Maintaining a friendship under such circumstances felt increasingly untenable to her.
