

INTERAMBULACRAL

Meaning: INTERAMBULACRAL: relating to the plates or regions of an echinoderm, such as a sea star, that are located between the ambulacral areas and contribute to structural support and function.

1. The interambulacral plates of the sea star provide structural support and protection for its internal organs.
2. In echinoderm anatomy, the interambulacral regions play a crucial role in locomotion and feeding.
3. Researchers studied the interambulacral areas to better understand the evolutionary adaptations of marine species.
