Meaning: INTERDICTIVE: having the quality of prohibiting or forbidding certain actions or behaviors to protect the community or uphold social norms.

3. In legal terms, interdictive measures can be essential for maintaining public order.
4. The interdictive stance of the organization was clearly communicated during the press conference.
