Meaning: Interfoliate: to insert or alternate layers or elements within a sequence or arrangement, such as pages or data, for enhanced visual or analytical effect.

2. Scientists often interfoliate different types of data to gain a clearer understanding of complex phenomena.
3. To enhance the texture of the dish, the chef chose to interfoliate layers of pasta with rich sauces and cheeses.
