*Meaning: To interject means to interrupt a conversation or discussion with a comment or opinion.*

3. As soon as she started to tell her story, he couldn't resist the urge to interject with a joke.
4. The teacher asked him to wait his turn instead of interjecting while others were speaking.
5. It's important to listen actively and not interject unless you have something valuable to add.
