Meaning: INTERJECTING: the act of interrupting a conversation or discourse with a comment or remark.

1. She kept interjecting her opinions during the meeting, which frustrated her colleagues.
2. As he was speaking, she couldn't help interjecting with a witty remark that lightened the mood.
3. The teacher warned the students against interjecting while others were trying to share their thoughts.
