

INTERJECTIONALLY

Meaning: Interjectionally refers to the manner of expressing a sudden emotion or reaction, often in a spontaneous or exclamatory way.

1. Interjectionally, she expressed her surprise at the unexpected news.
2. The speaker paused interjectionally, letting the audience absorb the weight of his words.
3. He interjectionally exclaimed, "Wow, that was incredible!"
4. The novel's dialogue flowed interjectionally, capturing the characters' spontaneous reactions.
