

INTERLINEATION

Meaning: Interlineation refers to the insertion of additional text or notes between the lines of a written document, often for clarification or correction.

1. The interlineation of the manuscript added valuable context to the author's original thoughts.
2. During the editing process, the interlineation revealed important corrections that had been overlooked.
3. She carefully made an interlineation in the contract to clarify the terms for both parties.
4. The interlineation was marked in blue ink, signifying a change that needed to be approved.
