

INTERLINING

Meaning: Interlining is a layer of fabric placed between the outer fabric and lining of a garment to provide support, structure, or enhance the drape.

1. Interlining is often used in tailoring to add structure to garments.
2. The designer chose a soft interlining to enhance the drape of the fabric.
3. For a more polished look, she emphasized the importance of quality interlining in her sewing class.
4. Interlining can significantly affect the warmth and insulation of winter coats.
