

INTERMEMBRAL

Meaning: Intermembral refers to the ratio or proportions of the lengths of the limbs (forelimbs and hindlimbs) in primates, used to assess locomotion and evolutionary adaptations.

1. The intermembral index is an important measurement used in the study of primate locomotion.
