Meaning: INTERMINE (verb): To combine or merge resources or elements, often for a strategic advantage or to create new formations.

2. Geologists studied how the minerals in the region might intermine to create new deposits.
3. As the project progressed, the teams decided to intermine their efforts to improve efficiency.
4. The artists sought to intermine their styles, blending techniques to create a unique piece.
