Meaning: Intermittence refers to the quality of occurring at irregular intervals; not continuous or steady.

1. The intermitence of the rainfall made it difficult to plan the outdoor event.
2. Her enthusiasm for the project was marked by an intermitence that puzzled her colleagues.
3. The intermitence of the power supply caused several disruptions in the laboratory.
4. We experienced intermitence in the internet connection, leading to frustration during the meeting.
5. His intermitence in attending the rehearsals was a concern for the director.
