*Meaning: INTERMITTENTLY: adverb describing an action occurring at irregular intervals, not continuously or steadily.*

1. The rain fell intermittently throughout the day, making it difficult to plan outdoor activities.
2. She checked her phone intermittently, hoping for a message from her friend.
3. The machine operates intermittently, which has caused some delays in production.
4. He struggled to focus as the loud music played intermittently in the background.
5. The lights flickered intermittently, suggesting a problem with the electrical system.
