

INTERNODE

Meaning: Internode: the segment of a plant stem between two successive nodes, which can vary in length and is influenced by environmental conditions.

1. The internode of the plant became elongated due to the lack of sunlight.
2. Researchers measured the internode length to assess the growth conditions of the species.
3. During the experiment, they observed that the internode structure significantly influenced water transport.
4. The internode connects the nodes, playing a crucial role in the plant's overall architecture.
5. In certain species, the internode can be specialized for storing nutrients or water.
