*Meaning: To interpone means to interject or introduce a statement, objection, or idea in a discussion or legal proceeding.*

1. The lawyer decided to interpone an objection during the trial to challenge the admissibility of the evidence.
2. In the meeting, she chose to interpone her thoughts on the proposed changes to the company policy.
3. As part of the negotiation, he will interpone a counteroffer that better reflects the project's value.
4. The artist will interpone her own perspective into the discussion about cultural representation in modern art.
5. During the debate, he sought to interpone a historical example to support his argument.
