Meaning: Interscind: to formally rescind or revoke a previously established agreement or resolution.

1. The committee decided to interscind the previous agreement to ensure a more equitable outcome.
2. After much debate, the council voted to interscind the resolution that had sparked public outcry.
3. Due to changing circumstances, the team felt it necessary to interscind their earlier proposal.
4. In a surprising move, the company chose to interscind its merger with the rival firm.
5. The judge ruled to interscind the contract, citing a breach of terms by one of the parties involved.
