Meaning: INTERVENING: the act of becoming involved in a situation to alter the outcome or provide assistance.

1. The teacher felt compelled to start intervening when the bullying became too frequent.
2. Intervening in the negotiations proved to be crucial for reaching a successful agreement.
3. She considered intervening in her friend's relationship but wasn't sure it was her place.
4. The government is focused on intervening early to prevent further economic decline.
