Meaning: Intervent (verb): to become involved in a situation in order to change or improve it.

1. The teacher decided to intervene when she noticed a student struggling with the material.
2. In times of crisis, it is often necessary for governments to intervene to restore order.
3. Therapists may choose to intervene in a patient's life when harmful behaviors are identified.
4. It is crucial for parents to know when to intervene in their children's disputes with friends.
5. The international community felt compelled to intervene in the conflict to prevent further escalation.
