

INTRORSE

Meaning: Introrse refers to a botanical characteristic where petals or anthers open inward, directing pollen or parts towards the center or axis of the flower.

1. The introrse petals of the flower slowly unfurl as the sun rises.
2. In botany, an introrse anther opens inward, releasing its pollen towards the stigma.
