

INTROSUME

Meaning: Introsume (verb): To engage in deep self-reflection or contemplation, encouraging an inward exploration of one's emotions or thoughts.

1. The artist's latest exhibit aims to introsume the viewer into a deep reflection of their own emotions.
2. As the meditation session progressed, participants began to introsume and connect with their inner selves.
3. In her journal, she used writing as a tool to introsume her thoughts and feelings about the past year.
