

INTUITIVISM

Meaning: Intuitivism is a philosophical doctrine asserting that certain truths, particularly in ethics and mathematics, can be understood through direct intuition rather than through logical reasoning or abstract concepts.

1. Intuitivism suggests that moral truths can be known through immediate perception rather than through reasoning.
2. In mathematics, intuitivism emphasizes the importance of mental constructions over abstract entities.
3. Many philosophers debate the relevance of intuitivism in understanding ethical dilemmas.
