*Meaning: Intumescence is the process of swelling or expansion of a material or tissue, often due to heat or inflammation.*

2. In medical terms, intumescence refers to swelling caused by inflammation or injury.
3. The researchers noted the intumescence of the polymer as a critical factor in its performance.
4. During the experiment, the intumescence of the substance was measured to determine its reaction to the environment.
5. The artist used a technique that mimicked the intumescence of natural materials in her sculpture.
