Meaning: Inturbidate: to make a liquid, such as water, cloudy or turbid by introducing sediment or particles.

1. The researchers aimed to inturbidate the previously clear water sample to study the effects of sediment.
2. Efforts to inturbidate the lake were met with resistance from environmental advocates concerned about wildlife.
3. In an attempt to inturbidate the solution, the scientist added a fine powder to increase its turbidity.

5. To properly inturbidate the experimental group, the team introduced various pollutants and observed the reactions.
