Meaning: Inuncted: anointed or smeared with oil or ointment, often as part of a ceremonial or ritualistic practice.

1. The ancient text described the ritual in which the priest was inuncted with sacred oils.
2. After the ceremony, the king was inuncted to symbolize his divine right to rule.
3. In ancient Rome, soldiers were inuncted before battle to invoke the favor of the gods.
4. She felt a sense of serenity wash over her as she was inuncted with the healing balm.
5. The artist inuncted her canvas with layers of oil to achieve a rich texture and depth.
