Meaning: Invalidate: to make something ineffective or null, especially by providing evidence or reasoning that contradicts or undermines it.

1. The new evidence may invalidate the previous conclusions drawn from the study.
2. She felt that his harsh criticism could invalidate her entire argument.
3. If the signatures are found to be forged, it could invalidate the contract entirely.
4. The team's failure to follow protocol could invalidate their results in the eyes of the reviewers.
5. It is essential to address any errors promptly to avoid invalidating the research findings.
