Meaning: Invalidation refers to the act of declaring something, such as a contract or a claim, null and void or no longer valid, often due to new evidence or circumstances.

1. The sudden invalidation of the contract left the company scrambling for alternatives.
2. Her research faced invalidation when new evidence contradicted her findings.
3. The software update caused the invalidation of all previous user credentials.
4. He felt a deep sense of invalidation after his contributions were dismissed in the meeting.
5. The court's ruling led to the invalidation of several previous legal decisions.
