Meaning: Invectively means in a manner characterized by harsh, critical, or abusive language.

1. She spoke invectively about the unfair treatment she had received from her colleagues.
2. During the debate, he responded invectively to the accusations thrown at him.
3. The author wrote invectively against the corruption he perceived in the government.
4. In his speech, he criticized the policy invectively, leaving no room for doubt about his stance.
5. Their invective comments were aimed more at personal attacks than constructive criticism.
