

# INVOLUCELLATE

*Meaning: Involucellate refers to having a whorl of small bracts surrounding a flower or inflorescence, typically positioned beneath the main floral structure.*

1. The flower's unique structure included involucellate bracts that attracted a variety of pollinators.
2. Botanists categorized the plant as involucellate due to its specific arrangement of secondary bracts.
3. Involucellate species often display a distinct morphological adaptation that enhances reproductive success.
