2. She had spent years avoiding sweets, but ironically, she was diagnosed with diabetes just after her wedding.
3. Ironically, the teacher who preached about punctuality was the last to arrive at the meeting.
4. His attempt to impress her with his wealth backfired, ironically making him seem superficial instead.
5. Ironically, the book he recommended was about overcoming procrastination, even though he had yet to read it himself.
