

# IRRECOGNITION

*Meaning: Irrecognition refers to the experience of failing to recognize or identify oneself or one's surroundings, often resulting in feelings of disconnection or alienation.*

1. The artist felt a deep sense of irrerecognition as her once-familiar city transformed into a sea of unfamiliar faces.
2. In moments of crisis, the irrerecognition of one's identity can lead to profound feelings of isolation.
3. His childhood home, now unrecognizable, was a poignant reminder of the irrerecognition that time often brings.
4. She grappled with the irrerecognition of her own reflection, a stark contrast to the person she once knew.
5. The community experienced a sense of irrerecognition after the sudden onset of drastic societal changes.
