

IRREPENTANCE

Meaning: Irrepentance is the state of being unrepentant or unwilling to express remorse for one's wrongdoings.

1. His irrepentance in the face of his wrongdoings shocked everyone around him.
2. The character's irrepentance added a dark complexity to the story's moral themes.
3. Despite the consequences of his actions, her irrepentance made it clear that she had no intention of changing.
4. The judge noted the defendant's irrepentance as a factor in determining the severity of the sentence.
5. Irrepentance often leads to further isolation and conflict in personal relationships.
