

IRRESPIRABLE

Meaning: Irrespirable refers to air or an atmosphere that is unfit for breathing due to contamination or lack of oxygen.

1. The air quality in the abandoned mine was so poor that it became entirely irrespirable.
2. During the chemical spill, the nearby town was warned that the atmosphere had turned irrespirable.
