

IRREVOCABILITY

Meaning: Irrevocability refers to the quality of being impossible to reverse or change once decided or committed.

1. The irrevocability of their decision left them feeling trapped in a situation they could not change.
2. He pondered the irrevocability of his commitment, knowing it would alter the course of his life forever.
3. The contract included a clause emphasizing the irrevocability of the agreement once it was signed by both parties.
4. Her heartfelt letter highlighted the irrevocability of their friendship, despite the distance that separated them.
5. The judge explained the irrevocability of his ruling, making it clear that there would be no appeal.
