Meaning: ISM: A suffix used to denote a distinctive practice, system, or philosophy, often referring to a particular ideology or movement.

1. The philosophy of realism is often contrasted with various forms of idealism and other "ism" movements.
2. In sociology, the term "capitalism" refers to an economic system rooted in private ownership and the free market, distinct from other "ism" ideologies.
