

ISSUANT

Meaning: Issuant: a party or entity that issues or grants something, such as bonds or policies, and holds associated responsibilities.

1. The issuer of the bonds was considered the issuant in the agreement.
2. As the issuant of the policy, the company holds certain responsibilities.
3. In legal terms, the issuant must ensure compliance with all regulations.
4. The bank acted as the issuant for the new line of credit offered to businesses.
5. Investors often scrutinize the financial health of the issuant before purchasing securities.

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
