Meaning: JIBBER (verb): To speak rapidly and excitedly in a way that is difficult to understand or lacks clear meaning.

1. He started to jibber excitedly when he heard the good news.
2. The toddler began to jibber incomprehensibly, trying to express his delight.
3. As the coffee kicked in, she found herself jibbering about her latest ideas.
4. During the meeting, his mind began to jibber as the discussion grew more complex.
5. They could hear the distant jibber of the crowd as the concert began.
