Meaning: Judgement: the ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions, often reflected in a formal decision or opinion rendered by a jury or individual.

3. In the face of adversity, his judgement remained clear and focused.
4. The judge's judgement was influenced by the evidence presented during the trial.
5. She trusted her instincts, believing that her judgement would lead her to the right decision.
