

JURAT

Meaning: A jurat is a formal certification in an affidavit indicating that the signer has sworn to the truth of its contents before an authorized official.

1. The notary public completed the jurat, affirming that the signer had sworn to the truth of the document's contents.
2. In legal contexts, a jurat is essential for verifying that an affidavit was signed under oath.
