

KENTLEDGE

Meaning: Kentledge is a heavy weight, typically used as a counterbalance or stabilizing agent in construction and art applications.

1. The artist used a kentledge to ensure the canvas remained stable during the outdoor exhibition.
2. During the construction of the bridge, workers employed kentledge to counterbalance the weight of the materials.
3. As the boat rocked in the waves, the captain added kentledge to maintain its balance and prevent capsizing.

5. The design required careful calculations of kentledge to ensure safety under varying load conditions.
