1. The campers gathered dry leaves and twigs for kindling to start the fire.

3. He remembered to pack some kindling in his backpack for the overnight hike.
4. The kindling caught fire quickly, illuminating the dark forest around them.
5. In the winter, we always kept a stock of kindling by the fireplace for warmth.
