

# KNELT

*Meaning: KNELED: past tense of kneel; to have bent one's knees and rested them on the ground, often in a position of reverence, submission, or to perform an action closer to the floor.*

1. She knelt beside the flowerbed to get a closer look at the blooming roses.
2. In a moment of desperation, he knelt down to beg for forgiveness.
3. The soldier knelt in reverence as the flag was being raised.
4. During the ceremony, the bride knelt before her partner to exchange vows.
5. After the long hike, they knelt on the ground to rest and catch their breath.
