

KNITBACK

Meaning: Knitback (verb): To rework or redo knitted stitches in a piece of fabric, often to correct an error or continue the crafting process.

1. The designer decided to knit back the stitches to fix the mistake in her sweater.
2. After a long day, she enjoyed sitting in her favorite chair to knit back a scarf for her friend.
3. The knitback technique added a unique texture to the otherwise simple cardigan.
4. He was pleased with how quickly he could knit back the rows after a minor setback.
5. During the workshop, participants learned how to knit back seamlessly in their projects.
