Meaning: LACERATE: to tear or cut something, especially the skin or material, in a jagged or irregular manner.

1. The sharp glass shard could easily lacerate the skin if handled carelessly.
2. In his frustration, he let the knife lacerate the paper, leaving jagged edges behind.
3. The animal's claws were capable of lacerating its prey within seconds.
4. After the accident, the doctor treated the wounds that had lacerated her arm.
5. The storm's fierce winds lacerated the trees, leaving a trail of destruction in their wake.
