

LAGAN

Meaning: Lagan is goods or cargo that are placed on the seabed and marked for later recovery.

1. Lagan refers to goods that are placed on the sea floor, marked for retrieval later.
2. The shipwreck was discovered with its cargo of lagan still intact on the ocean bed.
3. Maritime law allows salvagers to claim lagan after a certain period if unclaimed by the owner.
4. While exploring the coastline, they stumbled upon a piece of lagan that had washed ashore.
5. The fisherman always keeps an eye out for lagan, hoping to find valuable items lost at sea.
