Meaning: LAM: to apply a protective or finishing layer to an object or to flee quickly, especially to escape from danger or authority.

1. The artist decided to lam the new painting with a glossy finish for added depth.
2. After hearing the sirens, he knew it was time to lam before the authorities arrived.
3. She used a lam technique to create smooth transitions between the colors in her artwork.
4. The detective suspected that the suspect would lam to another city to avoid capture.
5. He watched as the light from the lam flickered, casting shadows on the wall.
