Meaning: Lamina: a thin layer or sheet, especially in reference to a layer of material, such as paint or biological tissue.

1. The artist carefully layered the lamina of paint to achieve a rich texture in her work.
2. Under the microscope, the lamina of the leaf revealed intricate patterns of veins and cells.
3. In geology, the lamina refers to thin layers of sediment that build up over time.
4. The biologist noted how the lamina in the algae provided essential surface area for photosynthesis.
5. During the dissection, the students examined the lamina of the fish to understand its respiratory system.
