

LAMPBLACK

Meaning: Lampblack is a black pigment made from soot, often used in art and to create dark, rich colors or coatings.

1. The artist used lampblack to create deep, rich shadows in her painting.
2. After the fire, the walls were covered in layers of lampblack, giving the room a gothic appearance.
3. He mixed lampblack with linseed oil to make a durable and intense black paint for his project.
4. The soot from the chimney settled as lampblack on the windowsills, requiring frequent cleaning.
5. During the restoration, they discovered that the original artwork was painted with lampblack, enhancing its historical value.
